Website Subscriptions Introduced

With costs mounting, we were nearly faced with having to drop our website entirely. A decision was made to introduce a low annual subscription fee for access to the archives and that has helped keep us online. We are truly thankful to our subscribers.

Slight Drop In Numbers

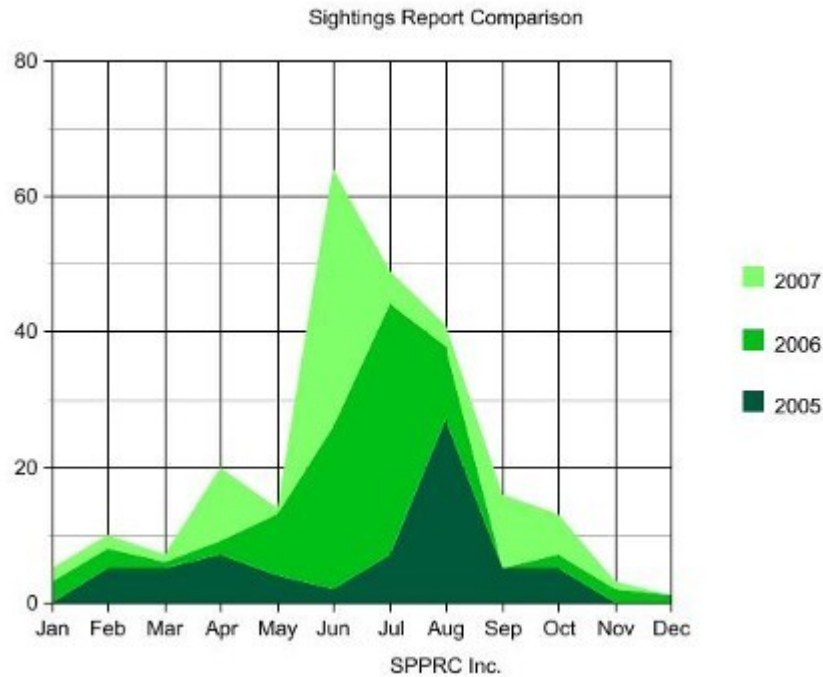
Sighting reports dropped only slightly in 2007 compared to 2006. This may mean that fewer people are reporting their sightings, or that fewer people have been outdoors watching the skies, or that there may have been a slight drop in unusual activity in our skies, or perhaps even that people feel their sightings are insignificant and not of any importance. *Every sighting is important to us*. No matter how big or small. Even those we are able to explain.

35 reports were *excluded* from the total 2007 summary because information was received by a *third party*. The witnesses were not willing to come forward for fear of ridicule from their peers and community members – even though anonymity would have been granted the witnesses felt community members would *single them out* immediately. These reports would have increased the provincial total and would have bypassed the previous year's amount.

We are aware of multiple sightings occurring on a regular basis over a number of years that go *unreported*. Members of those small northern communities have become *accustomed to the activities* and have accepted it as *part of normal every day life*. We need to hear from those areas as well.

Three Year Comparison

The chart below shows a sightings-by-month comparison over the past three years:



Shapes of Sightings Reported

The most common shape reported last year was *round*, followed by *spheres*. Next were triangles, star-like, and fireballs. Then finally lights, saucer, comet-shaped and orbs. There were a few reports where shapes were not mentioned.

Colours Reported

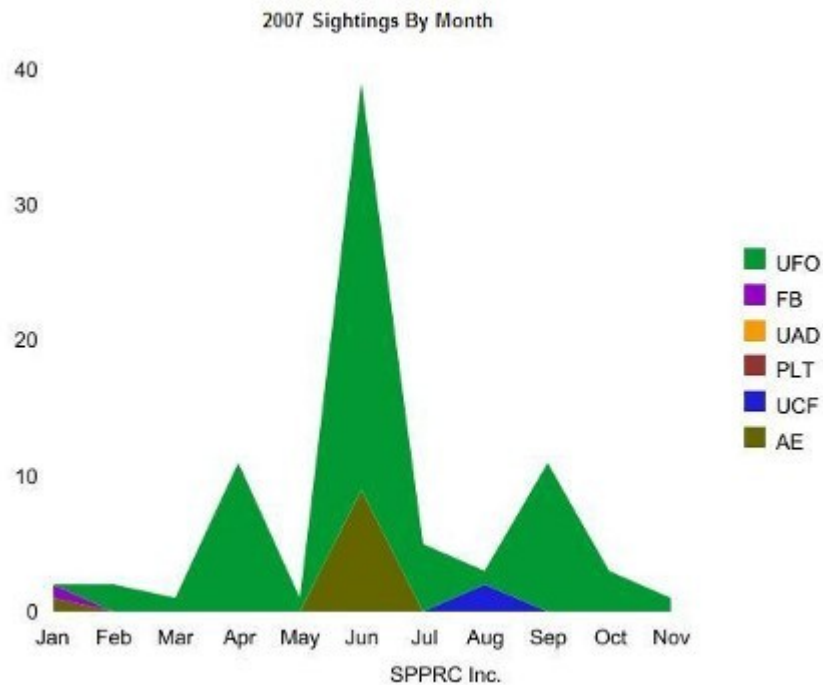
White	54	Multi*	3

There were several reports where colours were not mentioned.

* Witnesses referred to the colours as being 'multi' without defining any specific colours.

Sounds

The majority of witnesses say sightings occur with no sounds. Witnesses have reported sounds as being as *loud as a monster jet*, *loud as a helicopter* and *a steady hum*. Even after they had lost visual of the objects for as long as 30 minutes.



UFO = unidentified flying object

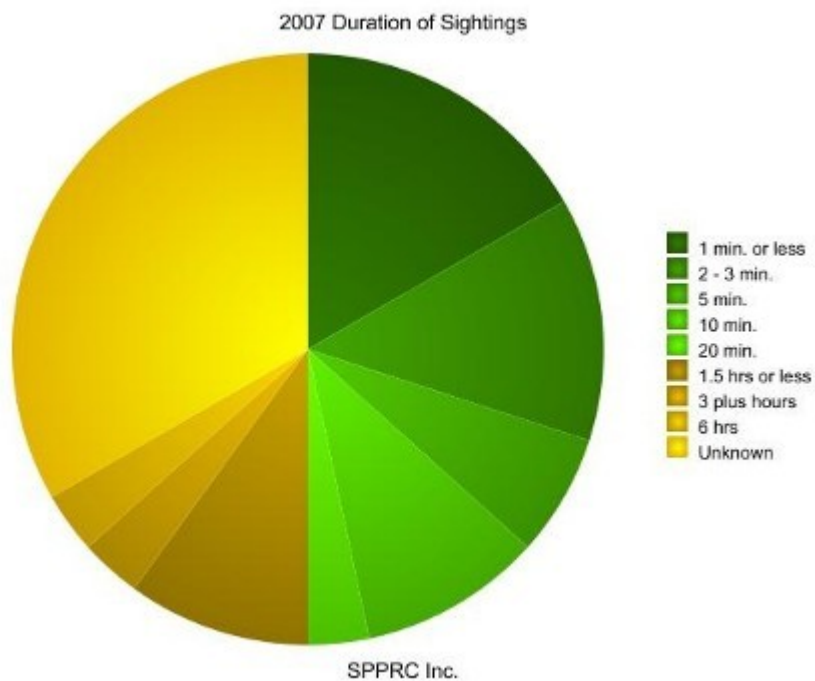
FB = Fireball, meteor

AE = alien encounter

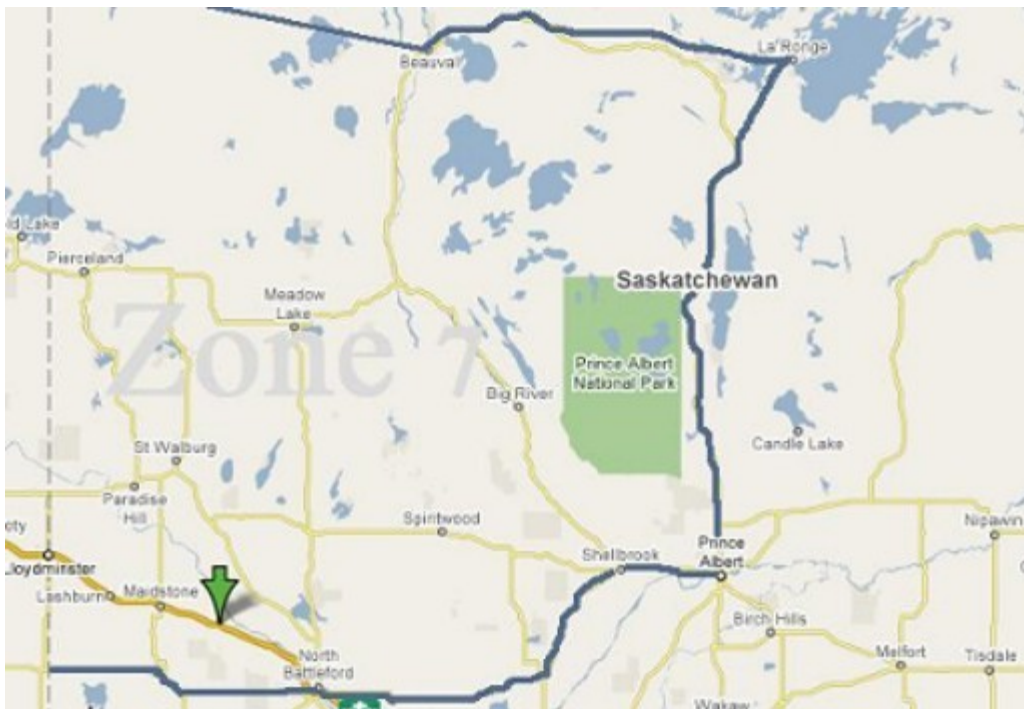


Most Sightings By Zone

Zone 3B reported the highest amount of sightings with all reports coming from the city of Saskatoon.

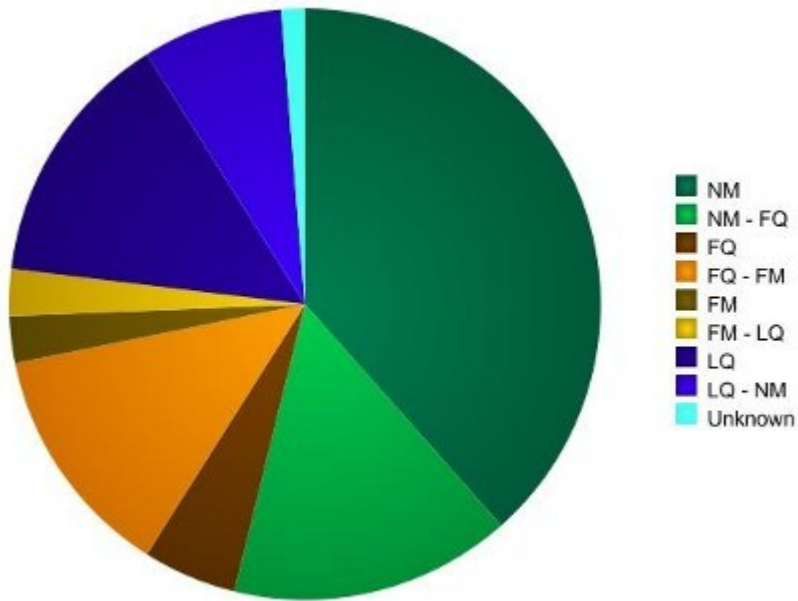


Zone 7 and Zone 3A were tied in second place.

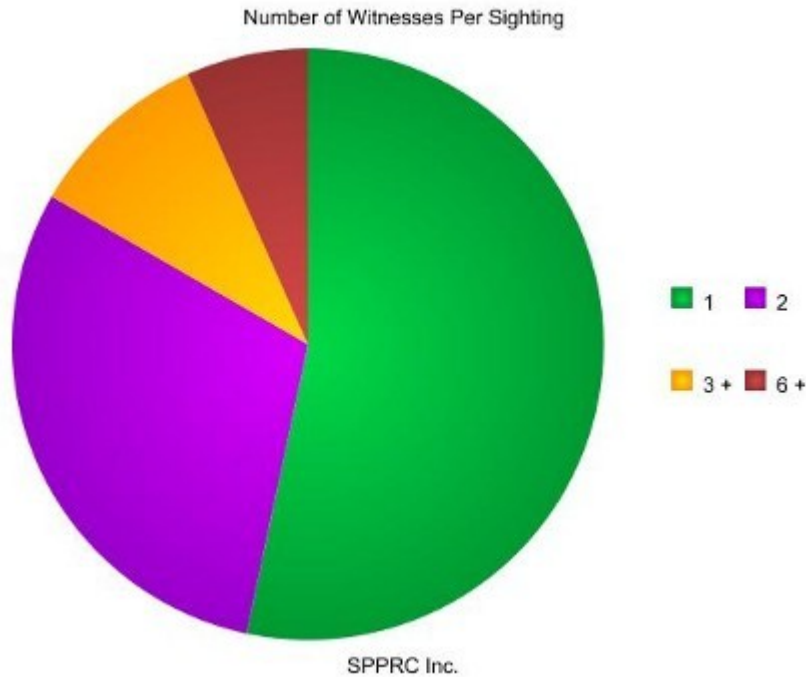




2007 Sightings By Moon Phases

Most Interesting Reports

January 14 – 20, near the Niska Bridge. A flying saucer (with 2 legs dangling below it) attempts to make contact with a car along a secluded road before a second car arrives into view. The saucer broke away from the car and then flew away. Saucer was described as having a foggy mid-section with multi-coloured lights. The legs from underneath the craft had lights as well. Duration of this sighting was given as 20 minutes long. Witness and occupant are considered to be very reliable. There was no reason to doubt their story of what had occurred that morning.

September 4, Saskatoon. 6 real big lights in a hexagon formation the size of three football fields silently glides over the city . As the formation slowly disappeared from sight, each light faded out individually from one another. Witness reported a slight haze around each light (which were 4 to 5 times larger than the stars). The duration of the sighting was 10 minutes.

UAD

There were no 'reported' unexplained animal mutilations in 2007. This does not necessarily mean that none had occurred. Unfortunately many farmers select not to report and just bury the carcasses. If we are to ever get any closer as to what is going on, we will need to hear from farmers effected. We need to examine those carcasses.

Alien Encounters

June 16, Grandora (6+ hours). Numerous lights combed the area. A metal craft appeared 30 feet in the air about 30 to 50 yards away from the witnesses. The sound was as loud as a monster jet. Gnome-like creatures and tall dark shadows were seen in the yard and around the home. A pup was mysteriously untied during the incident. An object allegedly followed a car passing through the area at the time. No PLT. No other witnesses. Psychic medium picked up on metal craft sighting however this location has heavy traffic from Saskatoon airport. Our team was on site for 17 hours. *Due to a number of factors there is little to no credibility of the sources.*

Further to this report:

Bigfoot Sightings

We received no reports of any sightings of bigfoot in this province last year. We are aware that these sightings have occurred around Prince Albert in the late 1980's and understand that more recent sightings have occurred in the more northern regions of the province such as La Ronge but have not heard directly from the witnesses.

Other Creatures

None reported last year. We have heard rumors that Lake Athabasca has some very unusual fish in its waters. We also heard rumors that we may have our own Mothman creature down in the southern part of the province. We would be interested in hearing from anyone who has any information they can share with us.

Hauntings & Demonic Activity *

North of Humboldt - *Brodyre House*. Three separate visits to the location. On the third visit level 5 activity was experienced. On a rating of 0 to 10 (10 being the most severe) this rated a 9. A blessing and smudging was performed. There was major concern for the safety of our client. Activity ceased in the home once our client moved out. Similar activity has occurred with a previous owner of the home which is why we are prepared to go back in there should this case need to be re-opened.

Zone 3A has an active case that needs attention. An initial visit was conducted but then timing was an issue.

** Cases must meet certain criteria before we will conduct an investigation.*
